SMMT Motorparc Data – Release of 2012 Census

SMMT Automotive Information Services has released the latest Motorparc data reporting on the UK vehicle parc at year end 2012

Motorparc is an annual service which SMMT has been providing to members since 1982. It is based on DVLA registration data and make/model specification data collected through the MVRIS new registrations system.

This year's figures show a continued slow increase in the car parc with a 0.4% growth to 31,481,823. Significantly, the average age of cars rose to 7.6 years which is the highest since 1983. The average CO₂ output of the car parc fell to 164 G/Km.
