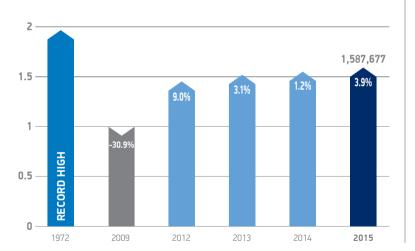

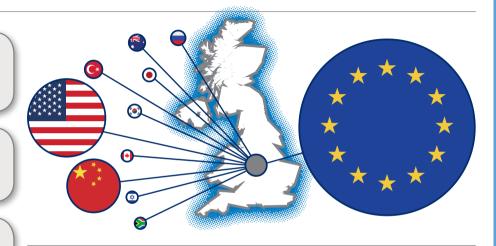

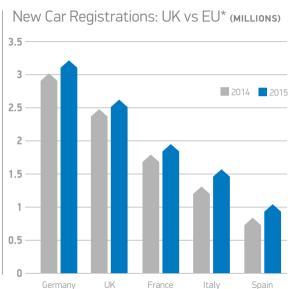

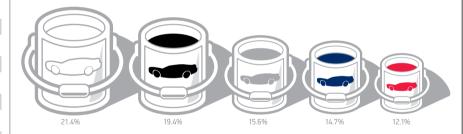

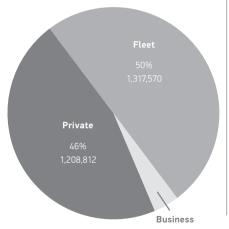

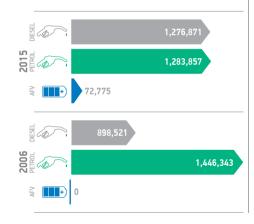

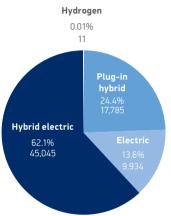

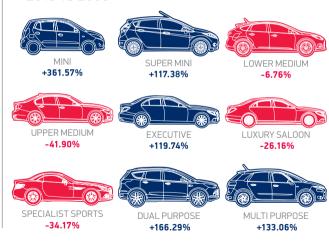
New car registrations by fuel type - 2006 vs 2015

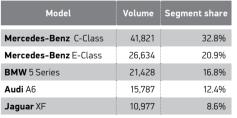

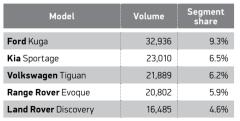

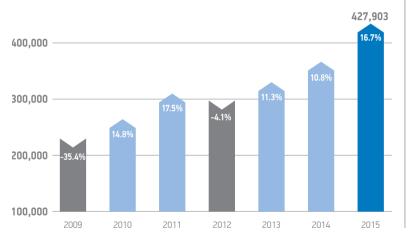
