Auto Expo 2014 – Components, New Delhi

6 – 9 February 2014

The Auto Expo Show, held every two years in New Delhi, is the key event for the Indian automotive industry and attracts the main businesses and stakeholders in vehicle manufacturing and component supply.

The Auto-Components sector is expected to grow by 11% over 2011-2020, to reach a turnover of US\$115 billion by 2020. The sector is boosted by an increased consumption of components by OEMs and a growing aftermarket.

For its 12th Edition, Auto Expo will be organised in two different locations: Auto Expo Components show organised at Pragati Maidan, from 6-9 February 2014 and Auto Expo Motor Show at Greater Noida rfrom 7-11 February 2014.
